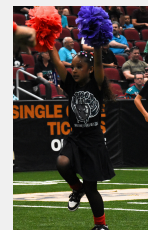

STUDENT SPOTLIGHTS

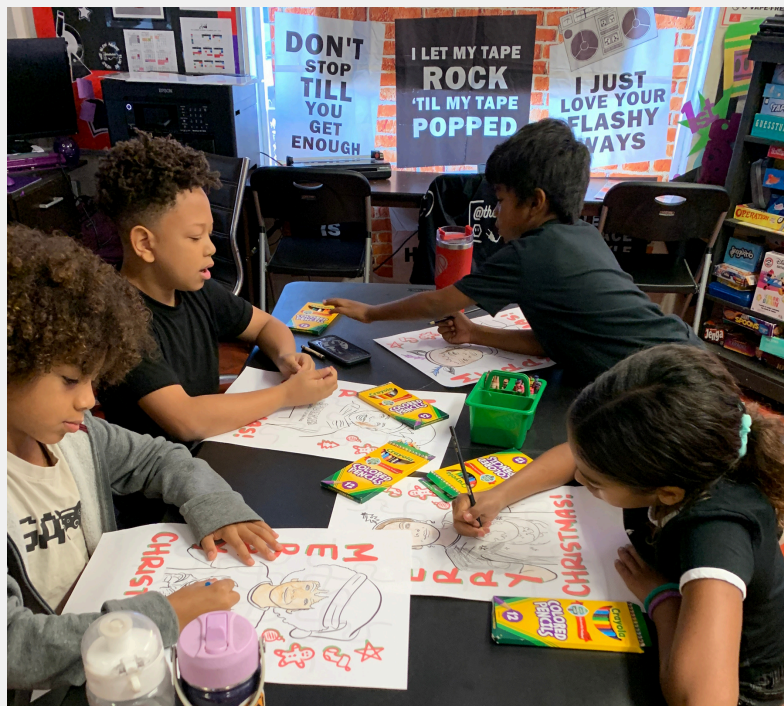
December was nothing short of electric for our ATO students, and they closed out 2025 shining brighter than ever!

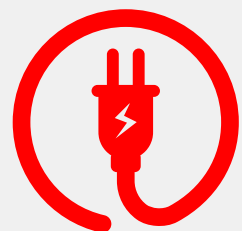
